



Introduction

Pergola Awnings are supported, retractable roofs that generally project from a building. Providing fully adjustable shade and shelter over a wide area, they make the perfect choice for larger terrace spaces. Constructed from durable materials and with minimal maintenance required, they are effectively an alternative to building an extension.

- Particularly well suited to covering large areas
- Metal pergola (steel, aluminium) or wooden pergola options available in a wide range of colours
- Motorised adjustment of shade and shelter
- Wall supported or free standing






Sizes


Pergola Awnings come in a wide range of sizes and can be used for anything from a small pub terrace to a large outdoor function space.








Wall Fixed

Fixing to walls or other surrounding structures where possible can help reduce the cost of a pergola awning, as well as maximising potential space.








Front Supports

This "Lean To" style is the most popular Pergola awning configuration, providing coverage around doorways and extending out over patios.











Upper Cantilever

When the height of a building or structure will allow, an upper-cantilevered fixing ensures great coverage without front supports causing potential obstructions.














Lower Cantilever

Lower cantilever fixings eliminate the need for front supports and can make for eye-catching design features.














Free-Standing

When there is no suitable building or structure to fix to, Pergola Awnings can be completely free-standing.











Butterfly

A simple "goalpost" structure fixed into the ground can be used to support two Pergola Awnings back-to-back.

This maximises the amount of coverage possible - up to 20 metres!





Flat

Using alternately pitched rails, Pergola Awnings can be totally flat and still allow water to run off the roof.

Alternatively, a "side-inclined" Pergola Awning can be given a very slight pitch.





Inclined

The most common style of Pergola Awning is pitched at 12-15° to allow water to run off the closed roof.





Curved

A variation on the traditional inclined roof allows for an eye-catching curved design.





Vaulted

Vaulted, or arched, Pergola Awning roofs make for a dramatic design statement and are particularly impressive from inside.





Enclosure

All our Pergola Awnings can be turned into dynamic outdoor rooms with the addition of side enclosure options. This could take the form of fixed glass, sliding/bi-fold doors or pull-down-vertical blinds and windows.










Screens

An alfresco area covered by a Pergola Awning can be further defined with the addition of Breezefree's SmartScreens and Café Screens. These can be standalone or integrated into the surrounding structure, providing additional shelter and opportunities for branding.






Fabric Membranes

Branding

Gutters

All our Pergola Awnings can be constructed with integrated or bespoke guttering to ensure your alfresco area remains dry.






Heating

The frame of a Pergola Awning is a perfect place to mount electric, infrared heaters to keep your customers warm and extend the use of you alfresco area into the cooler months.

If your Pergola Awning is fully enclosed, why not employ some lightless, ceramic heaters? These efficient heaters work best in draft-free environments and eliminate the orange glare of traditional heaters, allowing you to control the lighting more effectively.







Lighting

The cross-beams of our Pergola Awnings can be fitted with LED lighting to efficiently illuminate an alfresco area in the evening. The surrounding structure can also be fitted with up and down lighting for even more possibilities.





Sun, Wind & Rain Sensors

Weather sensors can be fitted to our Pergola Awnings to ensure roofs extend at the first sign of rain to automatically protect your patrons, or retract to protect themselves from damage during particularly strong winds.
